







Photography



Prioritize faces and people to bring a human aspect to BTP. Use images of people in action or smiling directly at the camera; avoid stock photos that look unnatural. Black and white photography is welcome, but avoid highly saturated color images. Photos with a shallow depth of field are preferred.



5A

Light trail backdrop

The light trail backdrop can enhance the technological feel of BTP. Always use it on dark backgrounds. Light trails should be used sparingly and reserved for digital displays or high-quality color prints on glossy paper.

Light trails images

Abstract light trail images can also be used as content in the absence of good quality photography. The light trail should evoke a stream and remain minimalist.


